Thank you for your recent inquiry on behalf of Mr. Dan Haley, of Tri-Technic, Inc., regarding the status of his firm's HUBZone application.

The time to process a HUBZone application is generally 90 days. Please keep in mind, however, that processing times for individual applications can vary greatly depending on the complexity of a case and an applicant's responsiveness to any requests for additional information. Mr. Haley's application was received on July 31, 2012, and supporting documentation was requested August 2, 2012, with a due date of August 16, 2012. We have not received any of the requested documents from Mr. Haley to date. Once we have the documents, we will review Mr. Haley's HUBZone application, and he will be notified as soon as a decision is made.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause Mr. Haley, but assure you his application will receive the same fair and thorough review as all other HUBZone applications.
